



Visiting agreement

You are visiting an inmate housed in a secure facility. Although we encourage visiting and believe that it has immense value for the inmate, it is not an unfettered right and can be revoked if you or the inmate you are visiting engage in conduct that is detrimental to the safety and security of this facility. The following is a code of conduct which you will be expected to adhere to.

Visitors shall not:

1. Bring contraband, packages, briefcases, purses, or other such items into the visiting area;
2. Use foul abusive or loud language;
3. Engage in suggestive or immodest behavior;
4. Re-enter the same day after leaving the visiting area (unless prior approval is given);
5. Bring a camera or a camera enabled device into the visiting area;
6. Enter the visiting area under the influence of alcohol or drugs;
7. Bring food or drink into the visiting are;
8. Dress in an overly revealing or sexually provocative manner.
9. Enter the visiting area, or allow another to enter with them prior to gaining approval for the visit.

Visitors Shall:

1. Remain seated during visits;
2. Conduct themselves in a quiet, responsible manner during visits;
3. Leave the visiting area promptly when notified their allotted time has elapsed;
4. Maintain control over any children who are brought into the visiting area or foyer;
5. Follow any directions given to them by administrative or jail personnel.
